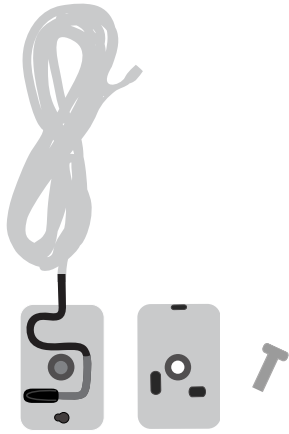


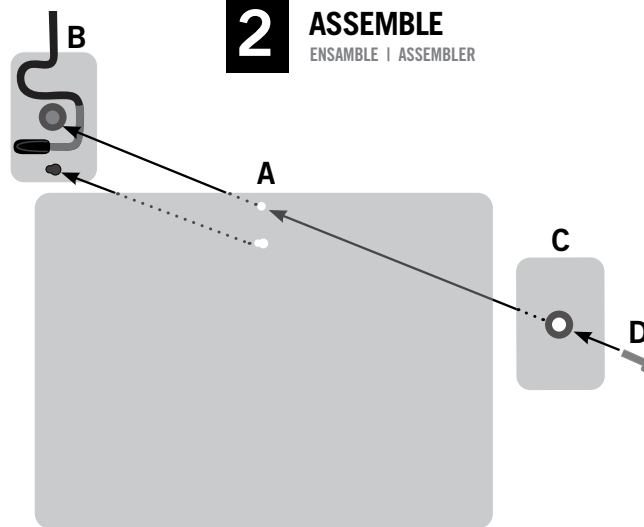

Phillips Head Screwdriver required for assembly (not included). Remove screw, carefully lift off cover.

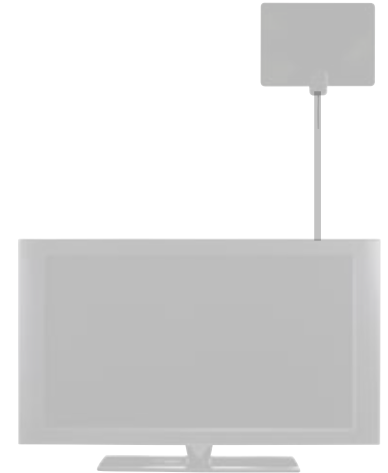
WARNING! DO NOT REMOVE THE CABLE FROM THE HOUSING!

Place antenna element (A) on cable assembly (B). Position top of cable assembly (C) over the antenna element. Re-insert the screw (D) and tighten carefully.

Connect to TV, run a channel scan.

RUN A CHANNEL SCAN

After connecting cable(s), position the antenna toward the broadcast tower for optimal reception. For a listing of likely channels available in your area, go online to dtv.gov/maps.

Run a channel scan, and note all channels that you are receiving. Try repositioning the antenna, and re-run a channel scan every time the antenna is repositioned, again noting all channels that you are receiving. Repeat until satisfied with the channels found.

Digital signals may bounce off of objects; for this reason, test the antenna in multiple locations before mounting the antenna. Secure the antenna with the provided 3M™ Command™ Brand Strip, which can be placed on any part of the antenna.

General Instructions for Running a Channel Scan*

1. Using the remote that came with the TV or converter box, select "Menu."
2. Select "Settings."
3. Select "Channel Setup" (if you have a converter box, skip to step #5).
4. Select "Antenna" or "Air." Make sure scan settings are not set for "Cable."
5. Select "Channel Search" or "Channel Scan."
Scan time will vary based on the number of channels available in your area.

*Steps to perform a channel scan may vary. Refer to your TV owner's manual for specific instructions for your TV.
